# THE BUZZ

The New England riding season has begun and we at Dieselbikes have hit the trails hard. We kicked off the season in the rain with our 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Lynn Woods Opener and held our first of four trail maintenance projects the last weekend in April. Both our weekend group rides and the Tuesday night rides are in full swing and this month will see the start of our Thursday night ride series.

Since we launched our E-RIDE campaign last month, we have received a number of e-mails and seen a few new faces on the trails with us. Remember: DB group rides are for all levels and our goal is simply to have fun. Sign up today and get out there with us!

# PICK & SHOVEL REPORT

Lynn Woods Reservation (LYW): Lynn, MA

On Saturday April 24 the first of four scheduled 2010 Lynn Woods trail projects was completed. It was a perfect day for trail building and we had a number of volunteers show up to help complete this project. We worked on the Espresso Trail. Our goal was to make some minor adjustments to the top two berms, while widening and building up the bottom berm to make the downhill run more "flowy".

We had 11 volunteers who worked hard digging, pulling up rocks and cutting trees to build up the third switchback at mid-level on the Espresso Trail. This switchback was not only widened but the apex of the turn was lengthened to provide better flow, allowing aggressive riders the opportunity to rail the turn. In addition, we tied up some of the loose ends on the upper two turns which hadn't been completed during a trail day last year.



The upper sections of Espresso are intact and appear to be extremely stable; they held up to all the periods of extended, heavy rain we have had over the past few months. Erosion does not appear to be a problem and the areas created for water drainage are behaving exactly as planned. We still have more work to do on the bottom section of Espresso with a planned installation of an off camber jump and a technical line over some large boulders, but that work will be carried out next year.

As usual, this was a large project to tackle in one day and the team of volunteers worked hard to get the job completed in five hours. I want to extend my personal thanks to every individual who helped complete this project. The amount of work completed by the volunteers was difficult and backbreaking, as working on a hillside always is, but we had a lot of fun, told a lot of jokes and enjoyed ourselves immensely. I look forward to seeing everyone again on future trail builds and maintenance projects.




# TRAIL THREADS

### Lynn Woods Reservation (LYW): Lynn, MA

Lynn Woods is officially open and the trails are in great condition despite the few large, and many smaller, fallen trees. As of right now, most have been cleared by the park ranger; remaining trees will be addressed over the coming weeks. If you find any blocked trails on your rides, please feel free to report them to us and we can relay the message back to park management.

Trail project discussions between NSNEMBA, Sinister Bikes and Dieselbikes are still in the works with Greenbelt, but unfortunately we may not be hosting a trail work project this month. If a last minute decision is made and we need volunteers, we'll let you all know!

There is a growing ATV matter that Greenbelt is trying to address which is putting a damper on some of the planned trail network improvements. A few of the trail enhancements completed last year by the above organizations have been damaged and continued work in this area may need to be put on hold until this ATV matter is addressed.

### Trail Network Disclaimer -

As always, please remember Tompson Reservation and B&T's trail networks span land owned by the Essex County Greenbelt and a number of private landowners. Currently mountain biking is permitted year round on the Greenbelt managed property called Tompson Reservation (TSR) but may not be permitted on adjacent private property. We ask that you use common sense when riding there; stick to the main trails and do not cut new lines/braids.

If you come across a change in a trail that you think is illegal, please do not change anything. Report it to Dieselbikes, Sinister Bikes and/or NSNEMBA. We have plenty of members who ride this location who will resolve any problems without creating potential conflicts. Efforts to improve the network will continue, though it will take some time to accomplish this goal with proper land manager approval.


4th Annual D-Day Mountain Bike Expo ~ Lynn Woods, MA Sunday June 27th, 2010




