### **Contest Rules:**

Below is a list of contest rules for the 2010 D-Day High Jump Competition. To ensure equal competition, all contestants must;

- a. Sign the contest liability release form & pay both expo admission of \$5.00 & jump contest entry fee of \$10.00
- b. Wear a bicycle helmet & have a bicycle to use during the competition.
- c. Start only at the designated starting line.
- d. Successfully jump over [with the bicycle] & clear the high bar without knocking it to the ground.
- e. Pass through the finish marker riding their bicycle.

### **Contest Layout:**

A starting line will be marked roughly 60 to 75-feet away from the beginning of the jump ramp. The maximum end height of the jump ramp is 20-inches. The high bar will be placed one full bike length [roughly 6-feet] from the end of the jump ramp.

The high bar will be placed 24-inches above [horizontal] the ground to begin the competition. Each contestant will start in the order they registered for the contest. Each contestant must place the center of their front wheel on the start line.

Once given the clearance to begin, the contestant must pedal towards the jump ramp and successfully jump over the high bar [with the bicycle] clearing it. The high bar is flexible and contact of the bar during the motion of jumping over is permitted; however, at no point can the high bar be knocked off of its supports at its given set height, contact the ground in any manner or be knocked down to a lower height from its set height. Any of the above conditions will eliminate you from the competition. Once a contestant has cleared and landed back onto the ground, they must proceed across the designated finish line approximately two full bicycle lengths [roughly 12-feet] away.

Upon completion of the first round, contestants that fail to clear the high bar will be eliminated [as stated above] and the height of the high bar will increase by 2-inches before the start of the next round. Once again contestants who fail to clear the high bar will be eliminated. This process will continue until a 1<sup>st</sup> place finisher has won.

### **Maximum Height:**

The maximum horizontal height of the high bar has been set at 60-inches. If at any point during the competition this maximum height is reached and multiple contestants remain, the starting distance to the jump ramp will be shortened by 5-feet while the maximum height of 60-inches remains. The process of shortening the starting distance by 5-feet will continue with each consecutive round until a 1<sup>st</sup> place finisher has won.

### **Landing Area & Finish Line:**

PLEASE NOTE: There is **NO CONSTRUCTED LANDING RAMP** for this high jump competition. All contestants will be landing onto flat ground as they attempt to clear the horizontal high bar. The finish line will be located approximately two full bicycle lengths [roughly 12-feet] away.

#### **Definitions**

The term “High Jump Competition” shall include activities that require you (participant) to jump over a supported flexible bar with your bicycle. The height of this flexible bar will start at 24” from the ground and increase during the competition; increasing the level of difficulty until a winner has been declared.

You will be required to manipulate your body and bicycle over the supported flexible bar in a manner determined by your best judgment and are aware by performing this function you will be jumping through the air without contact to the ground for a period of time that is influenced by your best judgment.

#### **Assumption of Risk**

I am aware I will be competing in a High Jump Competition with the use of a bicycle that involves risks, dangers and hazards. I am further aware the possibility of personally injury and or death could occur to me during this competition. I acknowledge and accept that the Event Sponsor & Operator and their staff may fail to predict whether the terrain or area in which the High Jump Competition is held is safe from; impact or collision with other riders; spectators; the failure to operate a bicycle safely or within one’s own ability or within designated areas; negligence of other cyclists; and negligence on the part of the Event Sponsor & Operator or their guides, volunteers and employees, including the failure to safe-guard or protect me from the risks, dangers and hazards of mountain biking.

**I am aware of the risks, dangers and hazards associated with the 2010 D-Day Mountain Bike Expo High Jump Competition and I freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting therefrom.**

## Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims and Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of the Event Sponsor & Operator allowing me to participate in the 2010 D-Day Mountain Bike Expo High Jump Competition and for the other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, I hereby agree as follows:

1. To waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against the Event Sponsor & Operator and their directors, officers, employees, guides, agents, independent contractors, representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns (all of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Releasees") and to release the Releasees from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury, including death, that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in mountain biking and this mountain bike event, due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, or breach of any statutory or other duty of care, on the part of the Releasees, and including the failure on the part of the Releasees to safeguard or protect me from the risks, dangers and hazards of mountain biking and participation in this mountain bike event referred to above;
2. To hold harmless and indemnify the Releasees from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my participation in mountain biking and this mountain bike event;
3. That this Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity;
4. That this Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the State of Massachusetts without regard to the conflicts of the law principles thereof; and
5. Any litigation involving the parties to this Agreement shall be brought solely within the State of Massachusetts and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the State of Massachusetts.

By entering into this Agreement I am not relying on any oral or written representation or statements made by the Releasees with respect to the safety of mountain biking, other than what is set forth in this Agreement.

**I confirm that I have read and understood this Agreement prior to signing it, and I am aware that by signing this agreement I am waiving certain legal rights which I or my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives may have against the Releasees.**
