



PICK & SHOVEL REPORT

Lynn Woods Reservation (LYW): Lynn, MA

On Sunday May 9th, the second Lynn Woods trail maintenance project was completed in record time. Eight volunteers attended this maintenance event to continue work on the Ridge Run Trail. The goal was to finish building a 50 foot section of trail that incorporated some new technical features to the existing terrain.

All eight volunteers worked hard digging and pulling up rocks to build these technical trail features. The original trail line running over a rocky section of trail was maintained; we added a sweeping turn to the exit area and installed runs over the tops of two exposed boulders.



I want to extend my personal thanks to each individual who took time out of their busy schedules and volunteered to help complete this project. Without this assistance from the riding community we wouldn't be able to maintain the trails we ride.

I look forward to seeing everyone again at future trail builds and/or maintenance projects.



The trail network in Lynn Woods is in awesome shape and we are happy to see a number of riders coming out to enjoy this great north shore riding spot. There has been a delay in removing a few fallen trees, but park management will make their way out this month to address the remaining downed trees. If you find any additional blocked trails on your rides, please feel free to report them to us and we can relay the message back to park management.

Spring trail work is done and we will be taking a break during the summer. The two remaining trail projects are scheduled for the fall. The DB crew along with other local riders will be out making some trail adjustments as required during the summer months so if you see something that appears to be newly cut, braids or trail damage, please feel free to drop us an e-mail so we can address the matter.



Tompson Reservation (TSR) / Bruce & Tom's (B&T's): Gloucester, MA

We are happy to announce the first of two trail work projects has been approved by Greenbelt. Sunday June 13th Greenbelt, in conjunction with NSNEMBA, Sinister Bikes & Dieselbikes will be hosting a maintenance project on Sunset Mountain Trail. We are hoping to get help from the riding community to complete this project. Rock moving, bench cutting and trail love are slated for June 13th. For more information, please visit our website.

There is a growing ATV problem that Greenbelt is trying to address which is putting a damper on some of the planned trail network improvements. A few of the trail enhancements completed last year by the above organizations have been damaged and continued work in this area may need to be put on hold until this ATV matter is addressed.

Trail Network Disclaimer -

As always, please remember Tompson Reservation and B&T's trail networks span land owned by the Essex County Greenbelt and a number of private landowners. Currently mountain biking is permitted year round on the Greenbelt managed property called Tompson Reservation (TSR) but may not be permitted on adjacent private property. We ask that you use common sense when riding; stick to the main trails and do not cut new lines/braids.

If you come across a change in a trail that you think is illegal, please do not change anything. Report it to Dieselbikes, Sinister Bikes and/or NSNEMBA. We have plenty of members who ride this location who will resolve any problems without creating potential conflicts. Efforts to improve the network will continue, though it will take some time to accomplish this goal with proper land manager approval.

Middlesex Fells Reservation (MFR): Stoneham, MA

DB has received a number of requests from the local riding community to become involved with the Fells' Trail Network and we believe this year may be the turning point for the Fells and the riding community.

This is just a quick update, but the meeting Dieselbikes and a number of other advocacy groups attended last month regarding the DCR's Trails Development Plan for the Middlesex Fells was very POSITIVE!

The DCR will have a public announcement shortly regarding changes to the Fells trails networks. Wish we could say more, but if you're a local rider to the Fells, you will enjoy the change.

DIESELBIKES EVENTS




4th Annual D-Day Mountain Bike Expo ~ Lynn Woods, MA Sunday June 27th, 2010

Scheduled DB Group Rides



Weekend Ride Sessions [April 18th through November 28th]

These public group rides typically take place both Saturday and Sunday with different locations depending on the club's schedule and weather conditions. Weekend rides can last 3-4 hours and offer plenty of fun and group camaraderie. None of these weekend sessions are fast paced. We're also not out to cover as much ground as possible. WE ARE OUT TO HAVE FUN & WE RIDE AT THE GROUP'S PACE! We ride technical trails and love to challenge our own skill sets. Anyone can join us to ride, watch or partake in the technical challenges our great New England trails offer.



Dieselbikes' Tuesday Night Rides will be starting their 4th season and we anticipate some new faces. Meeting time is between 5:45pm and 6:00pm at The Fat Cactus Mexicali Cantina parking lot; 215 Broadway Route 1N, Lynnfield MA, 01940. This is a two hour ride that takes place every Tuesday night (rain or shine) and breaks up the work week with a post ride gathering for food & refreshments in the restaurant. All levels are welcome and NO ONE is left behind!



Dieselbikes' Thursday Night Rides will be starting their 3rd season. Meeting time is between 5:45pm and 6:00pm at the Ballfield Parking lot, Great Woods Entrance; 78 Great Woods Road Lynn MA, 01904.
